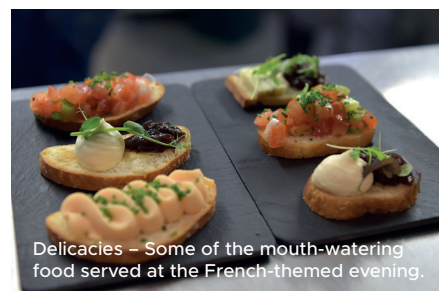
The Sanderson Weatherall team now looks forward to organising the event again for next year.
